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Title:	Engineering Day
Scope of Project/Request:	This event introduces students to civil, electrical, and mechanical engineering through real-world examples, short videos, and discussion led by a licensed civil engineer with extensive industry experience. The session includes a hands-on light saber project to practice basic electrical engineering concepts, integrates cross-disciplinary engineering ideas, and provides time for student questions, using curriculum and materials approved by Principal Gonzalez.
Items Requested:	Lithium Batteries, Black Electrical Tape, LED lights, Straws
Related Learning Objectives and Beneficiaries:	Supports Florida 5th-grade science standards: Obtaining, evaluating, and communicating information as students learn about what engineers do and ask questions, planning and carrying out investigations during the hands-on engineering build.

Title:	Enhancing Small-Group Reading Instruction Through Flexible Seating and Visual Supports
Scope of Project/Request:	This grant supports the purchase and implementation of flexible seating and instructional materials for one 5th-grade reading classroom at Beachland Elementary School in Indian River County. Funds will be used exclusively to purchase small-group stools that can be stored easily when not in use and anchor chart paper to support small-group reading instruction.

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	The project is classroom-based and focused solely on reading instruction, including guided reading groups and targeted literacy interventions. Materials will remain in the classroom for continued use in future school years.
Items Requested:	Small Group Stools (stackable/easy storage) Anchor Chart Paper (multiple pads)
Related Learning Objectives and Beneficiaries:	<p>This request supports school and district literacy goals by enhancing small-group reading instruction, improving student engagement, and supporting differentiated instruction. Flexible seating allows students to participate more comfortably and focus during guided reading, while anchor charts provide visual references that reinforce reading strategies, vocabulary, and comprehension skills.</p> <p>The requested materials are durable, easy to store, and designed for long-term use. This grant will have an immediate and lasting impact on student learning by improving the structure, comfort, and effectiveness of small-group reading instruction.</p> <p>This project will benefit approximately 50 fifth-grade students during reading instruction. The subject area supported is English Language Arts (Reading).</p>

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Related Learning Objectives and Beneficiaries:	<p>K-5 ESE-VE students.</p> <p>This classroom is new to Portable 2, and most of its materials are hand-me-downs. The rug at the back of the room is heavily stained and, despite cleaning attempts, the stains are permanent. Replacing the rug would help create a cleaner, more welcoming learning environment.</p> <p>In addition, this rug will provide students with a visual tool to help them communicate their feelings with the teacher when needed.</p>

Scope of Project/Request:	<p>Our general education math teachers have requested additional materials for students who complete their assigned work in class and need additional activities for differentiation and enrichment.</p> <p>These materials have been used and vetted by Mr. Kolesnik and Teacher of the Gifted, Debra Morse (i.e. these materials have been selected specifically because they are different from what is already available and fill specific needs in order to provide more well-rounded math enrichment during the school day).</p> <p>These materials are also important because while there are more computer-based options available for math enrichment, students also need, and will benefit from, having these hands-on, analog/pencil&amp;paper options for math extension available. Teachers can xerox the worksheets from the books as needed. These materials also encourage collaborative learning opportunities for students working in small groups.</p> <p>Furthermore, Mr. K would like to re-establish a competitive Equations Game team at Beachland, as he has done for many years, but needs these game sets to move forward.</p>

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Related Learning Objectives and Beneficiaries:	All requested materials in this grant are grade-level standards aligned for grades 3-5 and can be shared by all math teachers in those grade levels, to be used with any and all students who would benefit from differentiated, extended math activities at any point in a school year (can be unit-specific), and gives the teachers the flexibility to reach for high-quality enrichment activities that are already organized by subject matter. These materials could also widely be widely given to entire gen-ed classes, as extension activities to deepen their understanding of subject matter. Additionally, these materials would be used by Mrs. Morse, the gifted teacher, and any math specialists working with kids in pull-out groups.
